March is going to be very busy right up until the end of term. It starts on Thursday March 1st with World Book Day. We ask on this day that the children come to Nursery in their Pyjamas and bring along their favourite book from home, (with their name inside please!), this can be in Arabic or English, and a soft toy so we can snuggle up and read our stories!

On this day we also have a visit from Drs Nicholas & Asp Small Mouths Program. This will be an exciting way for the children to learn about good oral hygiene and diet, followed by a complementary dental checkup. The Drs' visit for this day has been cancelled by the Doctor, we will advise you of the new date once we receive it.

We will be holding parent conferences in the week beginning Sunday March 11th, look out for the sign up list on the board outside your child's classroom. This is an opportunity for you to talk with your child's class teacher about your child's progress to date.

Topic wise we have two more weeks looking at People Who Help Us. The children have been fascinated learning about the roles and responsibilities of people in our community. Each class looks at a different service each week,. During their focus on the Fire Service the child learn how to 'Stop, Drop and Roll' in the unlikely event their clothing should ever catch fire and what number to call in an emergency!

During the last week of term our topic will be Spring and Mummy! We will sing for Mummy on Wednesday March 21st and hold a Spring Bonnet Parade on the last day of term. We ask that you make a bonnet at home with your child, (we will send an email nearer the time with some ideas!), and bring it to Nursery for the parade on Thursday March 22nd. The Importance Of Reading To Your Child

Just 10 minutes reading and sharing a book with your child every day can make the world of difference to your child's development. Reading aloud combines the benefits of talking, listening and storytelling within a single activity and helps to build the foundations for language development. From stories your child learns many things such as how to listen and concentrate, new words and an understanding of why things happen. They also learn how to put ideas in order, develop their memory skills, notice how spoken words relate to words and pictures on a page and learn how to predict what might happen next. Find 10 minutes on World Book Day and every day to read with your child. It doesn't just have to happen at bedtime - reading and sharing stories can happen anywhere at any time so...cosy in and enjoy the moment!
